KATERI BROW GRANTS

- The Foundation's Kateri Brow grants, which range from \$1,000 to \$10,000, grants were recently announced. These grants are named for a past superintendent of the Issaquah School District and are awarded for programs that reflect vision and innovation in education.
- The 2018 grant recipients included programs at Discovery and Maple Hills elementary schools; Maywood Middle School; Echo Glen School; and Liberty, Skyline and Gibson Ek high schools.
- Grants included the purchase of ripple tanks, which are a fundamental tool for studying two-dimensional wave behavior that is otherwise difficult to investigate interactively. The number of students taking physics at all levels has increased year after year, resulting in the need for more tanks.


