Issaquah Food and Clothing Bank (IFCB) Program Updates

Tools 4 School

This annual event is for children in grades K-12 in the Issaquah School District, who need extra financial assistance, to provide them with high quality, brand new backpacks filled with school supplies. This program is a partnership between the Issaquah Food and Clothing Bank and the Issaquah Schools Foundation, working together to ensure all students in the Issaquah School District have the tools and resources they need to succeed.

This year's event will take place at Clark Elementary School on Aug. 1, from 4-8 p.m., and Aug. 2, from 9 a.m.-2 p.m. Registration is open for interested families.
